Risk of Adverse Reaction

Anaphylaxis, a severe allergic reaction, is exceedingly rare in patients treated with sublingual immunotherapy (SLIT), but it is important that you become familiar with the symptoms and proper response in case of emergency.

Anaphylaxis Symptoms

Anaphylaxis is a "systemic reaction," which means that your body may be affected far from the allergen's entry site. Symptoms vary from mild to severe and may occur alone or in any combination:

- SKIN: hives, swelling, itchiness, warmth, redness, rash
- BREATHING: wheezing, shortness of breath, throat tightness, cough, hoarse voice, chest pain/tightness, worsened nasal congestion/hay fever-like symptoms, trouble swallowing
- STOMACH: nausea, pain/cramps, vomiting, diarrhea, itchy mouth/throat
- CIRCULATION: pale/blue color, poor pulse, passing-out, dizzy/lighheaded, low blood pressure, shock
- OTHER: anxiety, feeling of "impending doom," red/itchy/watery eyes, severe headache, cramping of the uterus

Reactions may occur within minutes of exposure to an allergen, or they may be delayed for hours. It is possible for symptoms to resolve briefly and recur or progress hours later.

Anaphylaxis is a medical emergency that requires immediate treatment.

If you experience symptoms of anaphylaxis, use your Epinephrine Auto-Injector and call 911 or have someone drive you to the nearest emergency room. You should review the instructions that came with your Auto-Injector so you are prepared to use it if the need ever arises.
