



Allergy Treatment Options

Allergy DROPS¹

- **Painless, easy** and self-administered at home in just two minutes
 - Just a few drops under the tongue each day
 - Ideal for kids and adults with busy schedules
 - Don't interfere with medications
- **No restrictions** for sports and activities
- **Low cost** – about \$2 per day²
- **Safe for all ages** – from young children to seniors
- **Convenient** for travelers
 - No refrigeration necessary
 - Small bottle is appropriate for carry-on luggage
- **Drops are customized** to the patient's allergies
- **Endorsed by the World Health Organization** – contain the same FDA approved antigens as allergy shots
- **Relief typically begins** within 12 weeks and provides long-term remission of symptoms



Allergy SHOTS

- **Appropriate** for all allergy sufferers
- **Insurance plans** often pay for injections but patient may be responsible for copay and deductible³
- **Weekly injections** must be administered in healthcare facility
- **Parent and child** must stay in clinic for 30 minutes after injection for observation to ensure there is no adverse reaction
- **Patient cannot participate in sports activities for two hours** before or after allergy injection due to increased risk of anaphylaxis
- **Shots cannot be administered** to patients on certain medications
- **Patient must carry** an epinephrine injector on treatment days
- **History of success in the U.S.** with allergy specialists
- **Provides long term remission** of symptoms
